

The OBD port is usually found on or under the dash on the driver's side. Other possible locations are the centre console area or inside the glove compartment.



- The GPS antenna is located at the top of the unit, therefore please mount the unit in the **UPRIGHT** position (plug exiting from bottom)

Note that the device must be secured to a solid location in the vehicle.

Please ensure the cable or device position will not interfere with vehicle operation.

The use of cable ties is common but care must be taken to make sure the device cannot move and is secure to the vehicle structure.

This is important for the crash detection technology to perform well. Attach multiple cable ties in various directions when possible.



Do not start engine

- *After connecting the device, please wait 1 minute.*
- *After at least 1 minute has passed, Start the engine and let it run.*
- *Once the vehicle has been running for at least 5 minutes, the device will automatically detect the vehicle type it is connected to. You can now turn off the engine and remove the key.*
